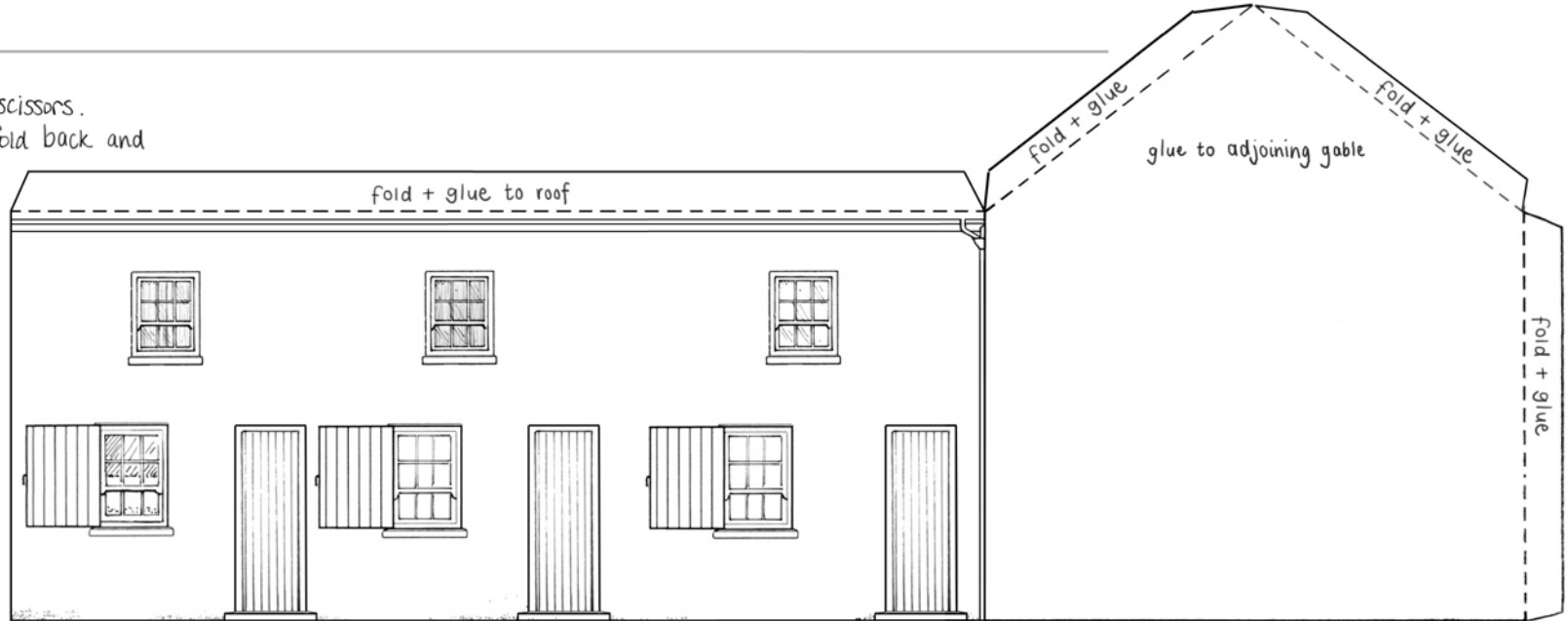
These six houses were originally built in the late 1820s for brickyard and textile mill workers in the Sandy Row area of Belfast.

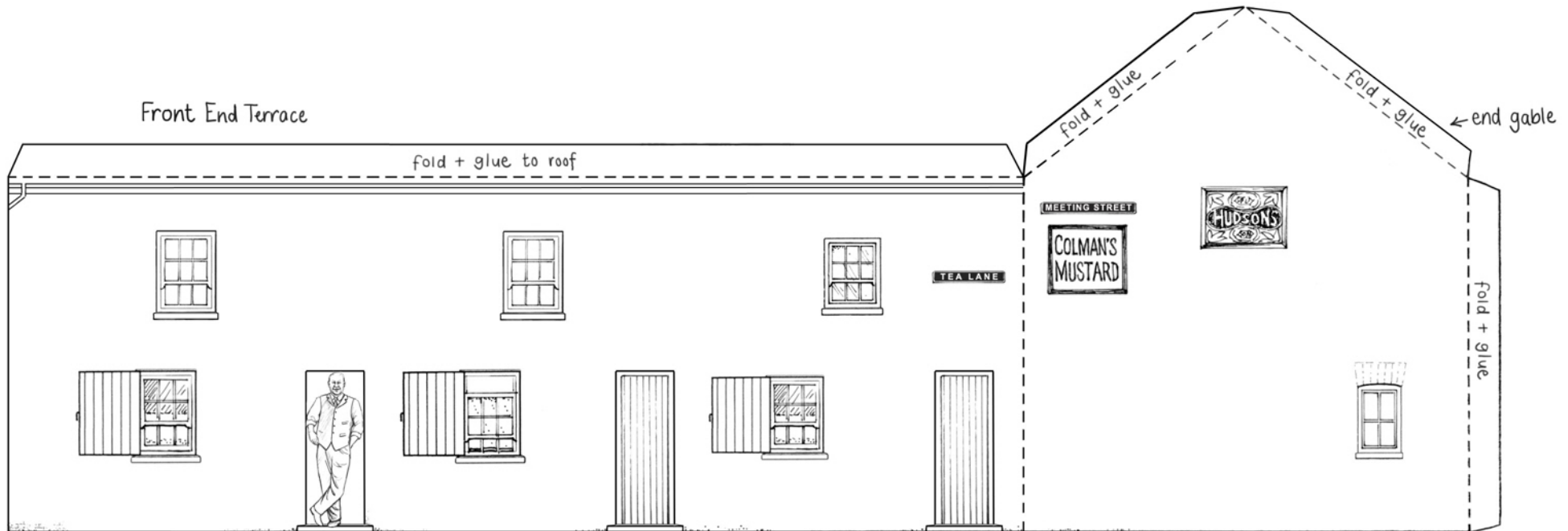

This end of the terrace adjoins the corner shop building →



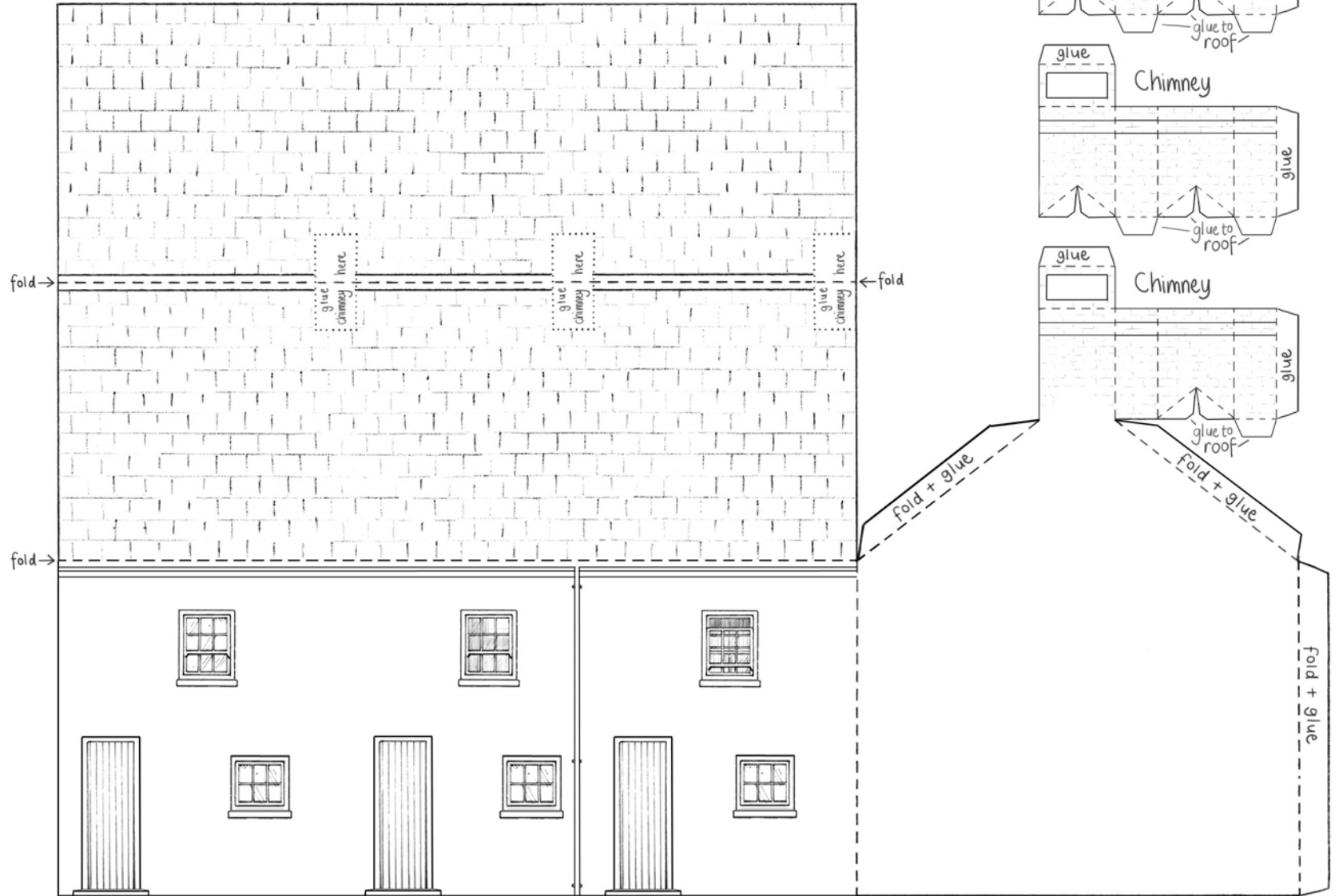
