

## Go Create! Gallery

### How to take part:

- Follow the *Go Create!* instructions on each project page and make your very own museum-inspired creation. Or draw a picture of your favourite museum object.
- Once you've finished, find a brightly lit spot to take a photo of your piece.
- Hold your camera or phone parallel to the page as you take a photo. Try to zoom in as close to the edge of the page or the object as possible.
- Ask your parent or guardian to email the image to us with your first name and age ONLY to: [education@nmni.com](mailto:education@nmni.com)
- Then look out for your entry here on our Go Create! online gallery.

### Eligibility:

Go Create! Gallery is open to submissions from any primary school-age child in Northern Ireland. We will accept up to 4 submissions per child each week. We will attempt to include all submissions on our online gallery, as long as they fulfil the rules below.

### Rules:

- All entries must be sent by a parent or guardian on behalf of their child to the email address provided.
- Do not include anything in the photo that could identify you to other people. If you do, we cannot include your submission.
- You must only send photos of work you have created yourself.
- Submissions are checked before they appear on the online gallery. We will only publish images suitable for a primary school audience.

### Privacy:

The information you provide will be used to associate a name and age to each submission and processed securely for the purpose of creating Go Create! Gallery. If your submission does not fulfil our rules, we will notify you and delete your data after two weeks. Every image uploaded to the home school gallery, along with the child's name and age, will be stored indefinitely by National Museums NI. We will not share your personal data with any third party without your prior consent, unless required by law.
